"Character Mask Making"

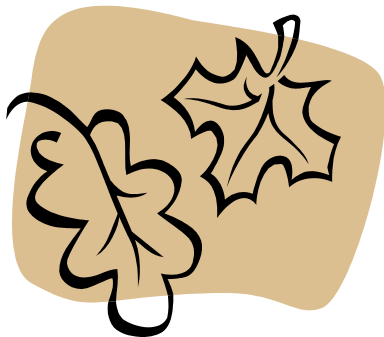
Recommended for ages 13-18
